Posting three very consistent times within three seconds of each other wasn't enough to take the day win leaving Lynn second overall for the third time running! This solid start to his 2011 season now leaves Lynn currently leading the Southern Centre Enduro Championship.

Meanwhile teammate Ryan Callaghan continues to show top form in the Great Stuff Catering Motocross Championship. Competing in the Grade B MX1, Callaghan now sits second overall but only three points adrift of the championship lead. With the series continuing this Sunday, Ryan will be eager for more success.

Robert Lynn: "Glendalough turned out to be another good result finishing second. Overall I felt I rode strongly all day and only made some small mistakes here and there but managed to keep them to a minimum. It's becoming a little frustrating to keep finishing second but I'll take it as they come. At the minute I'm now leading the Southern Centre championship so with more races left to run this year hopefully I can bag that win I want! I'd also like to thank Shark helmets and TCX boots for their support this season"
