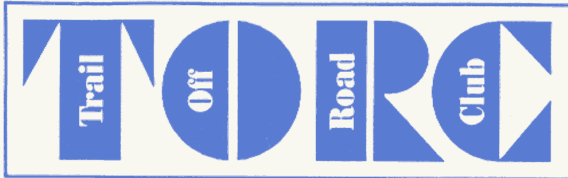

- 5 **ENTRIES** must be made on the official entry form and sent to the secretary of the meeting, together with the entry fee. **To Include Pig Roast on The Sat Night.**

The entry must be received by the 26th October 2011; otherwise late entry fees will be imposed for entries received after that date. There is no limit on the number of entries. All riders must hold a current National license issued by the **MCUI**. – Or - their own National License with a starting permission issued by their National affiliate of the **FIM**. (FMN). **Please apply for one Event Licences before the event. Ulster Ctr and MRA. one Event Lic available from your Club or Center**

- 6 **TECHNICAL CONTROL and REGISTRATION. Sign-on** will be open from 9am on Saturday and **7am on Sunday. Sign on will close at 11.00am sharp on Saturday and 8.30am on Sunday** Riders must then present their motorcycles for inspection 45 min before the start each day . Each machine must be in accordance with article 140 of the GCR’S of the **MCUI** and comply with the standing regulations for Enduro’s of the **MCUI**. A noise test will be carried out in accordance with technical rules. The **RIDER** will be asked to present his helmet complete with a current **MCUI** helmet stamp. **Tyres** must be of FIM approval for Enduro use.
- 7 **STARTING ORDER**, will be in compliance with art.062.34 First bike will depart @ **12.01am Saturday 29th and @ 10.01am on Sunday 30th. Caution..... Clocks Go Back This Weekend**

- 8 **COURSE** will be forest tracks, some “fire road” Open Mountain, and public road’s. There will be a number of lap’s of not less than **50Km long**. There will be **ONE “ET”** (Enduro test) per lap and one free run through the test will be at the C.O.C.’S discretion. **Petrol:** There will be a refueling point at the START/FINISH area. **NO PLASTIC CANS ALLOWED.** There are 2 VIA checks on the Course. There are 2 sections of 2 Way Traffic.
- 9 **PENALTIES** will be in accordance with Art.062.64. No tear off’s for goggles are allowed, due to the obvious litter they cause.
- 10 Only entrants who have paid the relevant fee and official marshals are permitted to be on the course or any of the lands rented out by the club at the event on motorised vehicles. No spectators or followers of competitors are permitted to use any form of motorised vehicles including pit bikes, quads and motorbikes.
- 11 **VOLUNTEERS: Any person abusing a volunteer before, during or after the event will be subject to disciplinary action as laid out by the MCUI General Competition Rules. It is hard enough to get voluntary helpers to run events for you, so please respect them at all times. If you have an objection to any aspect of the event please direct it in the appropriate manner to the Clerk of the Course or MCUI Steward.**
