1 The **TORC MOTORCYCLE CLUB** will host the following Enduro Championship rounds on the 27th & 28th of Aug 2011 starting at 11am on Saturday and 10am on Sunday in Killavullen G.A.A. Club, Co Cork. Grid Ref O/S sheet 80-or- 73 W 648 998

- 2 **PERMIT.** Held under permit from the **MCUI (SC) ltd.**, Number TBA Enduro under the General competition rules and standing regulations for **ENDURO'S** of the **MCUI**.
- 3 ACCESS. Killavullen is just off the N72 which runs between Fermoy and Mallow.
- 4 SECRETARY of the Event. TORC, C/O Colin Maher, 10 Lanesborough Terrace, Meakstown, Dublin 11.
- 5 **ENTRIES** must be made on the official entry form and sent to the secretary of the meeting, together with the entry fee.

Entries received before 25th Aug 2010 Late Entries

The entry must be received by the 25th August 2011; otherwise late entry fees will be imposed for entries received after that date. There is no limit on the number of entries. All riders must hold a current National

- license issued by the **MCUI o**r their own National License with a starting permission issued by their National affiliate of the **FIM.** (FMN)
- TECHNICAL CONTROL and REGISTRATION. Sign-on will be open from 8.45am on Saturday, 8am on Sunday. Sign on will close at 10.00am sharp on Saturday and 9.00am on Sunday. Riders must then present their motorcycles for inspection. Each machine must be in accordance with article 140 of the GCR'S of the MCUI and comply with the standing regulations for Enduro's of the MCUI. A noise test will be carried out in accordance with technical rules. The RIDER will be asked to present their helmet complete with a current MCUI helmet stamp. Tyres must be of FIM approval for Enduro use.
- 7 **STARTING ORDER**, will be in compliance with art.062.34 First bike will depart @ 11.01am on Saturday and 10.01am on Sunday.
- 8 **COURSE** will be forest tracks, some "fire road" Open Mountain, and public roads. There will be a number of laps of not less than **40 miles long.** There will be **ONE** "**ET**" (Enduro tests) per lap and one free run through the test will be at the C.O.C.'S discretion. There are 3 time checks on Sat and 2 on Sunday
- 9 Petrol: It will be announced closer to the event as to the amount of fuel stops on each day. The main refueling point is about 1 mile from start area. Competitors must get fuel to the refueling point themselves. NO PLASTIC CANS ALLOWED. Any plastic cans found at the refueling point will be removed.
- 10 There <u>WILL</u> be an overnight Parc-Ferme. (Please remember to bring locks with you for the overnight parking.
- 11 **PENALTIES** will be in accordance with Art.062.64. No tear off's for goggles are allowed, due to the obvious litter they cause.
- 12 VOLUNTEERS: Any person abusing a volunteer before, during or after the event will be subject to disciplinary action as laid out by the MCUI General Competition Rules. It is hard enough to get voluntary helpers to run events for you, so please respect them at all times. If you have an objection to any aspect of the event please direct it in the appropriate manner to the Clerk of the Course or MCUI Steward.
